Adult Members should also be aware of the Australian laws governing the use of social media, including the issues of defamation, privacy, child protection, discrimination, bullying and harassment, copyright and intellectual property. For example, making derogatory and untrue statements about an individual may constitute defamation, harassment or bullying.
