Dress Rehearsal/Performance Expectations and Information

Personal Items

- Please ensure all your belongings, costumes, socks and even shoes have your name on them.
- Make a list of your cast supply items and keep this handy to make sure you pack everything you need.
- All cast must wear skin-coloured underwear, plain black trousers, black shoes and socks. Girls should wear a skin coloured singlet or crop top under costumes.
- All cast members need a dressing gown to cover costumes when eating/drinking.

Arriving/Leaving the Theatre

- Comet cast are to meet outside the stage door before their performances. Comets will be met by a Comet Commander/Leader and then brought inside together.
- Comets are to wear their dressing gowns/a warm jacket when arriving and leaving the theatre. Comets should also wear their Gang Show shirt, scarf and black pants (no tights please) and black socks/shoes.
- Comet cast perform in the first act only and are then to be collected by parents in the courtyard at interval (9:00pm for evening shows and 3:30pm for matinees).
- Please contact Jenny Wardell if you are running late – 0413 589 243.
- Cast members must show their theatre pass to be allowed into the theatre, and are only permitted to enter the on the evenings/afternoons that they are performing.
- Family and audience members are not permitted through the stage door or in backstage areas.

At the Theatre

- If you are sick, contact Jenny Wardell and stay home to avoid spreading your germs. Jenny's number is 0413 589 243, please contact her as **early as possible** so that your parts can be covered.
- Hair must be brushed and tied back, no jewellery is to be worn.
- Jewellery/valuables are to be left at home.
- Comets need to bring a pop/flip top water bottle.
- Comets must eat before coming to theatre. They may bring a small snack (eg, packet of chips) in case they get hungry.
- Dressing gowns must be worn when in the catering area and when having makeup applied/removed.
- Listen for announcements in dressing rooms/corridor and keep an eye on the TV screens so you know what is happening on stage. Do not touch or change TV settings.

On Stage

- **Listen to instructions, follow directions and be silent in the wings.**
- Stand behind curtain legs when waiting to enter, this will ensure that cast exiting have plenty of space to get through.
- If you can see the audience they can see you! Remember your instructions about when and where to enter and exit.
- DO NOT TALK on stage. Anywhere. Anytime. Battleaxes will be given.
- Do not sit or crouch down – this makes it really hard to see you and you could get bumped over or hurt.
